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Rotary Club of Century City Corporate Membership Program

General

Rotary is an organization of individual members. In some cases, however, the traditional form of Rotary membership may not be appropriate for a particular individual. Examples include:

- More than one employee of a firm wishes to join Rotary, but is unable to do so due to classification limits
- A prospective Rotarian is unable to devote sufficient time to Rotary functions due to the demands of his or her business

For this reason, the Rotary Club of Century City developed its Corporate Membership Program.

How It Works

In our Corporate Membership Program, one individual from the firm is designated as the Lead Member. This member is the firm's official representative in all Club and Rotary International activities.

In addition, up to three Associate Members may be designated. Associate Members enjoy all of the benefits of membership in the Rotary Club of Century City, and are encouraged to attend all Club, District, and Rotary International events.

Financial Commitment

The Lead Member is responsible for all of the financial and other commitments of individual Rotary membership. There is no additional cost for Associate Members, except as follows:

- The cost of weekly luncheon meetings attended will be billed, except that there will be no charge for luncheon meetings attended by an Associate Member as an alternate for a Lead Member who is unable to attend.
- The cost of special Club, District, and Rotary International events attended will be billed.
- Associate Members who have not yet become Paul Harris Fellows are assessed for a quarterly donation of \$25.00 to The Rotary Foundation. A Paul Harris Fellow is a Rotarian who has contributed at least \$1,000 to the Foundation. Once the \$1,000 level is reached, the quarterly donations are no longer required.

All Lead Member and Associate Member costs and assessments will appear on a consolidated billing in the name of the Lead Member.
